Gregory "Todd" Byrd participated in the Skills USA Championships in Kansas City recently. More than 5,000 students competed in 96 occupational and leadership skill areas.

Byrd competed in the CNC Milling Competition. Accompanied by his instructor, Mr. Jerry Majovsky, Todd represented himself and KCCC in an outstanding manner as he placed 6th in the nation in this competition.

Given a blueprint and a part, he had to write a CNC program calculating radii and offsets using trigonometry and geometry functions. He then had to machine the part to exact dimensions and tolerances.

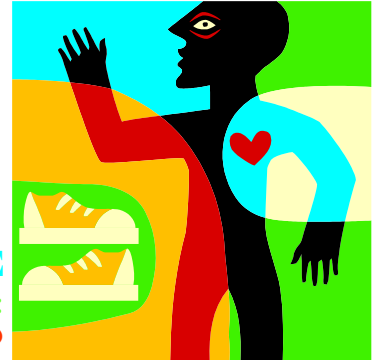
